FENCE MAINTENANCE:

Trimming vegetation outside the pest proof fence. The area outside the fence needs to be clear for at least 5m to prevent pests from jumping in. This will be focusing on low growing manuka along the southeastern area edge of the reserve.

Sunday 13th August

TRAP REFURBISHMENT:

Dismantling and cleaning of DOC traps that have been brought in from the Halo project. A nice indoor workshop task

Sunday 20th August

OUTSIDE FENCE TRAP LINE CHECK AND REBAIT:

Checking and rebaiting DOC traps around the outside of the fence.

Sunday 27th August

FENCE MAINTENANCE:

Giving our fence some TLC - either cleaning the fence hood to keep this free of lichen or earth ramping to strengthen the fence
