HIGH RISK TRACKING CARD RUN—CARDS OUT:

HIGH RISK TRACKING CARD RUN—CARDS IN:

The goal will be to collect as many cards as possible on Sunday. This will give a good snapshot of any possible pest animal activity in the reserve.

Sunday 16th July

FENCE MAINTENANCE:

Removing some low growing manuka which is growing a bit too close outside the fence along the south eastern corner of the reserve.

OUTSIDE FENCE TRAP LINE CHECK AND REBAIT:

For something a little different, the DOC traps around the outside of the fence will be checked and rebaited.
