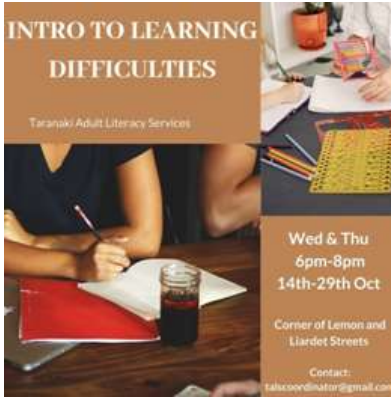


# TARANAKI ADULT LITERACY SERVICES



## An Introduction to Learning Difficulties

## Māori for Migrants

## Conversational Māori

Location: Literacy Aotearoa, Cnr of Lemon and Liardet Streets, New Plymouth

In this 9 week programme the focus is on speaking and listening including correct pronunciation of Te Reo Māori. Participants will gain an understanding of the stories associated with common everyday Māori terms and place names. Practise with partners conversing in different scenarios and practical applications. This course is learner focussed and is flexible to address the group's needs.

Course cost per participant: \$90.00.
