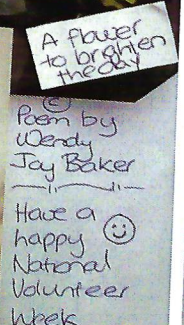
Poem For

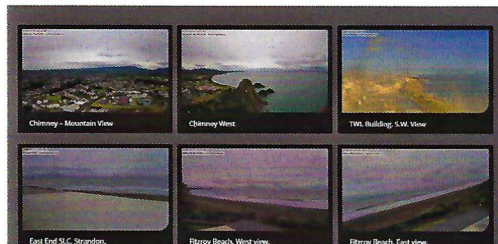
